Review the Project Rules



Have the students complete the Ethics Process before starting their project

- Projects involving living organisms (plant, animals, microorganisms, tissues), biological materials, potentially harmful chemicals, surveys, among other things, require ethics approval before registering to the science fair.
- You can take a short survey using the following [link](#) to determine whether Ethics Approval is necessary for your project.
- Failure to comply may result in ineligibility for awards and participation in upper-level fairs.




Have the students complete the Participant Registration on Zoho by **February 20**


UPPER-LEVEL FAIRS

Schools with projects selected for provincial, national, and international fairs will be required to pay the registration cost defined by the Réseau Technoscience network, and will assist in finding a chaperone.

Honorarium of \$50 will be requested of schools of selected projects.

Provincial Super-Expo Sciences:
~\$500 per student*

Canada-Wide Science Fair:
~\$2,000 per student*




** For projects coming from schools that are **not** from one of the following sponsored school boards or associations, **EMSB, LBPSB, SWLSB, or QAIS** schools, there is an additional **mandatory E.A.S.T. non-membership fee per project** payable upon project submission and registration.

IMPORTANT NOTES:

1. Check must be made Payable to "EAST" or "Educational Alliance for Science & Technology"
2. T-Shirts are mandatory and automatically included in the pricing. Exhibitors will pick up their sizes on site.
3. A late penalty of \$20 dollars (CDN) will be levied to each INCOMPLETE project (solo: \$130+\$20 or duo: \$135+\$20) submitted by a school past the due date. In special circumstances, the MRSTF may waive the penalty policy if advance arrangements – and in writing – are made with the MRSTF Coordinator.
4. A minimum number of regional judges must be recruited by the school, depending on the number of projects registered. Refer to the teacher's guide for detailed information.
5. There are additional fees charged for any student selected to attend the upper-level fairs (Provincials, Canada-Wide, International Events). It is expected that the school of a next-level fair participant – in conjunction with the guardians – will contribute to these registration fees. The fees will be confirmed shortly, but will likely be approximately:
Provincials: \$500 CDN per Exhibitor, **Canada-Wide:** \$2000 CDN per Exhibitor and **Regeneron ISEF (International):** Approx. \$2000 CDN per Exhibitor. For any **in-person event**, there is a chaperone fee (50\$) which is to help subsidize the costs of the chaperone.
6. The school of a selected next-level fair participant (provincial, national and international) will assist in finding a chaperone for the delegation. An honorarium and substitution for the teacher will be provided by EAST.
7. **A chaperone may be any person designated by the institution to be a legal agent of that institution. S/he is responsible for all persons from that institution.**
