

Review the Project Rules



Have the students complete the Ethics Process before starting their project



- Projects involving living organisms (plant, animals, microorganisms, tissues), biological materials, potentially harmful chemicals, surveys, among other things, require ethics approval before registering to the science fair
- You can take a short survey using the following link to determine whether Ethics Approval is necessary for your project.
- Failure to comply may result in ineligibility for awards and participation in upper-level fairs.



Have the students complete the Participant Registration on **Zoho** by February 20

- Students will require a teacher-in-charge's email as well as partner information if working in a duo
- Save all documents in PDF before submitting to the online platform.
